Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

Cabernet Sauvignon from the Martin Vineyard in the Coombsville area of Napa Valley. This dry southwest looking hillside produces stressed Cabernet with small crops and berry size.

Winemaker's Notes:

The small crop and berry size allows for full maturity of the grapes at lower sugar levels, allowing us to make a true regional and varietal wine. Being European trained, this vineyard allows me to produce a Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon as a balanced, complete wine. 14% Amador County Syrah was added to round out the tannins.

Tasting Notes:

27 months of barrel aging produced a well structured, chewy, firm wine with a aromas and tastes of violets, mint, Rutherford Bench dust, black fruits, dill and cedar, leading to a long, full finish.
