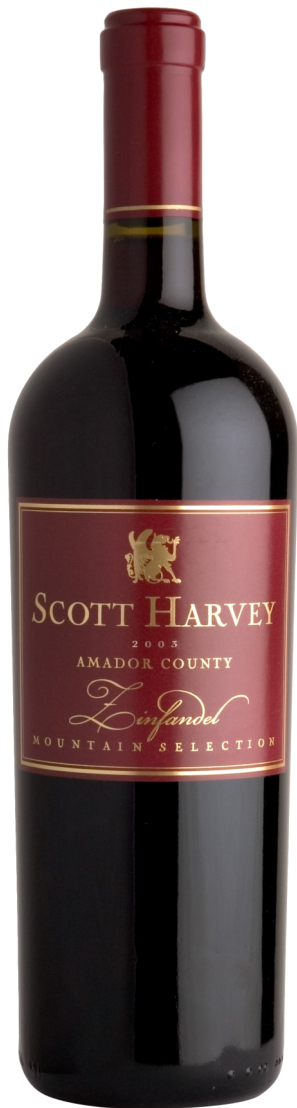

Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

Produced from the vineyards located in the Shenandoah Valley of Amador County. The granite soils of Amador County are well suited to producing distinctive, earthy, full bodied Zinfandels that have a wonderful character all to themselves.

Winemaker's Notes:

Forward and luscious, this lively wine almost jumps out of the glass. Briary, blackberry extractive Amador Zinfandel. French Oak aging contributes to the rounded complexity. Try this food friendly Zinfandel with any grilled meat or chicken, or pair with pizza, pasta and burgers!

Tasting Notes:

Flavors of allspice & cloves, bay leaf & holiday spices, raspberry tart and cherry cola; the wine has good balance with firm tannins, is complete with long lingering flavors & finish showing good European style and drink ability.

63% from the Bowman Vineyard (34 years old), 14% Vineyard 1869, 13% Manby Vineyard, 9% Norton (84 years old), 1% DeWitt Vineyard.
