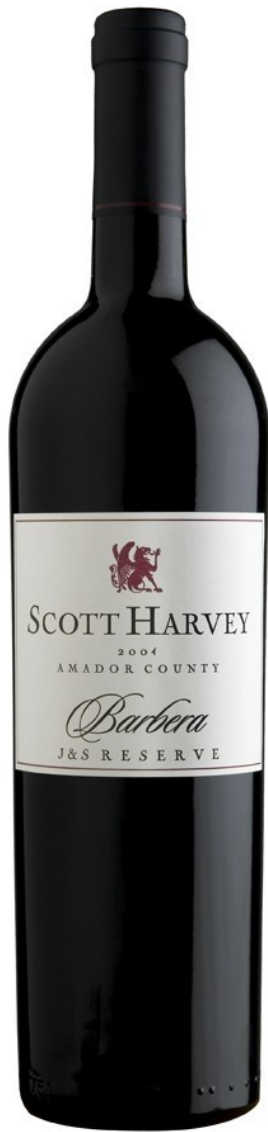

Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

A blend of the Manby Vineyard and Vineyard 1869 of the Shenandoah Valley of Amador County, California. Amador County is extremely well suited to Barbera. Barbera both buds out earlier and ripens later than Zinfandel producing grapes at lower pH and full bright varietal fruit. Barbera will eventually become known as the best variety for Amador County.

Winemaker's Notes:

Both vineyards produce small bunches of high extraction; and have the perfect pH and flavors to produce world class Barbera.

Tasting Notes:

Fruit forward, rich full flavors expressing both the varietal and the Amador Terroir. This complex wine has notes of cherries, pepper and blackberry with a bright center finishing with vanilla and spice.

20% Vineyard 1869 Barbera & Zinfandel, 80% Manby Vineyard Barbera. 100% Amador County.
