Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

Cabernet Sauvignon from the Martin Vineyard in the Coombsville area of Napa Valley. This dry southwest looking hillside produces stressed Cabernet with small crops and berry size.

Winemaker's Notes:

The small crop and berry size allows for full maturity of the grapes at lower sugar levels, allowing us to make a true regional and varietal wine at 14.5% alcohol. Being European trained, this vineyard allows me to produce a Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon as a balanced, complete wine. The wine was aged for 36 months in French Oak, creating a flavorful wine with well-rounded tannins.

Tasting Notes:

Well structured and chewy, with layered notes of violets and hints of mint.
