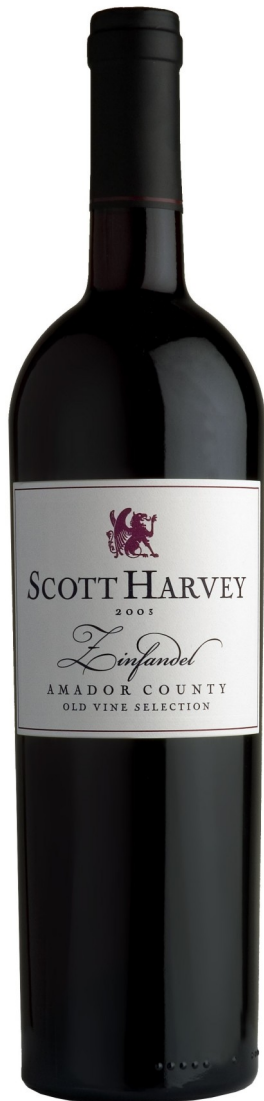

Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

100% DeMille/Norton Vineyard grapes from “84 Year Old Vines”. The 2009 harvest ripened in early October, letting the grapes mature without over ripening. This allowed for full flavor maturity, without extreme alcohol levels. The Norton Vineyard produced small bunches of high extraction. These old vine vineyards were planted in the days when horses were still used for cultivation. These are non-irrigated, stand-alone head pruned vines that express the Amador Zinfandel terroir.

Winemaker's Notes:

Produced in the old world style of balanced winemaking; we want the wine to express the Amador Zinfandel terroir with good balance of fruit, French Oak, structural tannins and medium alcohol.

Tasting Notes:

Briary varietal Zinfandel with notes of deep raspberry, allspice, cloves and peppermint, balanced with a rich full center of chocolate-covered cherries and reminiscent of steak tartar. The long, lingering finish shows a complete wine from beginning to end. Old Vine complexity with first growth quality.
