**Vineyard/Vintage Notes:**

Produced from the Harvey Vineyard, America's oldest Zinfandel Vineyard documented as existing in 1869. This ancient vineyard is non-irrigated, stand alone head pruned vines that fully express the Amador Zinfandel terroir.

**Winemaker's Notes:**

Produced in the "Old World" style of balanced winemaking. We want to express the Amador Zinfandel terroir with a good balance of fruit, French oak, structural tannins and medium alcohol.

**Tasting Notes:**

Briary varietal layered Zinfandel with notes of blackberry, fig, pomegranate and violets. Balanced with a fleshy center and hints of coffee and bright currents.
