Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

100% from Amador County. Amador County is extremely well suited to Barbera. Barbera both buds out earlier and ripens later than Zinfandel producing grapes at lower pH with full bright varietal fruit. Amador County is rapidly becoming known as the best wine growing region in the world for Barbera. 2018 was a vintage of larger than average size with a late bud break and harvest. The longer hang time into the fall of 2018 allowed the grapes to ripen fully developing good extractive and flavorful wines.

Winemaker's Notes:

Amador County Barbera produces small bunches of high extraction, perfect pH and flavors to produce world class Barbera.

Tasting Notes:

Dark color, clean and fresh with a hint of mulberry, this fleshy and varietal Barbera has a rich long extractive finish.
