100% grown in the mountainous York Vineyard of Fiddletown, Amador County. This lava cap of steep rocky volcanic slopes of the Sierra-mountain terrain represents well Amador County's ability to produce world class Syrah. These mountain terroirs produce low yields of first growth quality fruit. Harvest on September 27th, 2018. 2018 was a vintage of long hang time that produced red fruit wines with developed flavors and good acidity.
