Produced from the Wilderotter vineyard in the Shenandoah Valley of Amador County. Small yields of flavorful grapes were harvested early to produce a light, low alcohol European style dry Rosé of Barbera.

Winemaker's Notes:

Making this wine gives me a chance to produce a true European type Rosé in a light, crisp and dry style, like the wines we produced while I was working as an apprentice and going to winemaking school in Germany. This wine is made in the German "Weißherbst Kabinett" style.

Tasting Notes:

Good balance, light white pepper on the front palate with a fresh crisp finish. Saskatoons, strawberry, violets, macintosh apple, fresh rain on a dusty road, elegant are all great descriptors for this delicate light picnic Barbera Rosé.
