Vineyard/Winemaker Notes:

50% produced from a special clone of Pinot Noir brought to the United States by Dr. Richard Peterson and 50% from an already existing clone of Pinot Noir. Both clones are from the Alarid Vineyard in the Santa Lucia Highlands of Monterey County, CA. Small yields of flavorful grapes were harvested at the point of ripeness, producing a delicate European style Pinot Noir. Produced in a true “Old World” style, similar to the wines we produced while working as an apprentice and going to winemaking school in Europe.

Tasting Notes:

This wine has good balance and a fresh, crisp finish. Aromas and flavors of bright cherry, raspberry, white pepper, cranberry and dust after a fresh rain.
