Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

Produced 89% from the Harvey Vineyard, America's oldest Zinfandel Vineyard documented as existing in 1869. "Vineyard 1869" was planted in the days when horses were used for cultivation. This ancient vineyard is non-irrigated, stand alone head pruned vines that fully express the Amador Zinfandel terroir.

Winemaker's Notes:

Produced in the "Old World" style of balanced winemaking. We want to express the Amador Zinfandel terroir with a good balance of fruit, French oak, structural tannins and medium alcohol.

Tasting Notes:

Briary varietal layered Zinfandel medium claret color, majoram, spice, cigar tobacco, bright cherry, medium French oak, and layered complexity.

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
