Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

100% grown in the mountainous York Vineyard of Fiddletown, Amador County. This lava cap of steep rocky volcanic slopes of the Sierra-mountain terrain represents well Amador County's ability to produce world class Syrah. These mountain terroirs produce low yields of first growth quality fruit. Harvest on October 4th, 2019. 2019 was a small yielding vintage of long hang time that produced red fruit wines that are extractive and balanced.

Winemaker's Notes:

Produced in a drinkable fruit forward and rich style. Aged 18 months in French oak cooperage to develop a well-rounded wine with firmly structured tannins for delicious drinkability.

Tasting Notes:

Varietal, dark color, briary, Boysenberry bramble, clove, BBQ steak and extractive spicy flavors laced with firm tannin that carry through to the long soft finish.
