## Vineyard/Vintage Notes:

Grown in the mountainous York Syrah Vineyard of Fiddletown, Amador County. This vineyard is a steep rocky lava cap west facing slope. Extremely low yields from these highly stressed mountain vineyards produce first growth quality fruit. It is planted to six different clones of Syrah brought over from France. The long drawn -out harvest of 2019 produced wines full of flavor maintaining both red fruit and acidity. Grapes came in with small bunches and berry size allowing for a more extractive vintage.

#### Winemaker's Notes:

Produced in an elegant Cote Blond French style. Elegant bright red fruits enhance this well-balanced wine. Aged in French oak cooperage to develop a well-rounded wine with firmly structured tannins.

### Tasting Notes:

Plum cake with back pepper, tobacco leaf and violets and wild flowers layered with developed grippy tannins that carry through to the long extractive finish. This a 15 to 20 year ager.

### Vineyard Sources:

100% Syrah, 100% 2019 from the Pam York Vineyard of the Fiddletown appellation of Amador County.
